In January 1988, the Supreme Court of Canada struck down legal restrictions on abortion in Canada. Since then abortion is allowed throughout all nine months of pregnancy.

More than 100,000 abortions were performed in Canada in 2004.\* Statistics Canada has gestational information on only 36,874, about one-third. Of those, 1755 were performed after 16 weeks; 401 after 20 weeks. 5 babies were aborted after 33 weeks gestation.
